



## Grade 5 Sample Lesson Plan: The Integumentary System

### Objectives/Goals

- Students will be able to identify the major structures and functions of the integumentary system.

### Materials

- Internet access

### Steps

- **Activity:** Remind students that three core functions of skin are to protect body from germs, to keep bodies at the right temperature, and to enable the sense of touch and ask students to develop a poster that illustrates one way to help protect each of the three core functions and protect the body from disease (e.g., wear gloves, wash hands with soap and water, trim nails, hydrate in the heat, wear warm clothing in the winter, wear sunscreen)

### Assessment Idea

- Evaluate student performance on quizzes and activities
